LIVERMORE (CBS SF) — An Oakland woman has been arrested for suspicion of child endangerment for allegedly leaving her two young children in her locked car on Sunday while she was gambling inside a casino in Livermore, police said.

Livermore officers responded to a call that two small children had been left unattended in a locked vehicle in the 900 block of North Canyons Parkway in Livermore at about 6:10 p.m. on Sunday.

They found two children, ages 2 and 3, who were strapped into their car seats and unattended, Livermore police said.

The childrens' mother, Phaley Nget, 37, was gambling inside Casino 580, according to police.

The children weren't injured, but Nget was arrested and the children were taken into protective custody, police said.
